



Travel aspects



The High-school in Slovakia


To begin, class hours are very different from our hours in France because the pupils begin at 7 a.m. and they finish at 2 p.m., in the meantime, they have lunch at noon. On the other hand, the hours of breaks are the same as in France. In addition, the courses are similar than France, except that instead of France it's Slovak. Their high school was composed of a management team such as France high school, principal, supervisions, teachers, ... In their school, you had to badge when you entered the high school to notify the presence despite that there was still a call. In Slovakia, there was a small school compared to Notre Dame with only 200 students.

Typical day and activities




